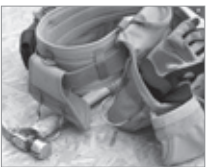

Building Project UPDATE



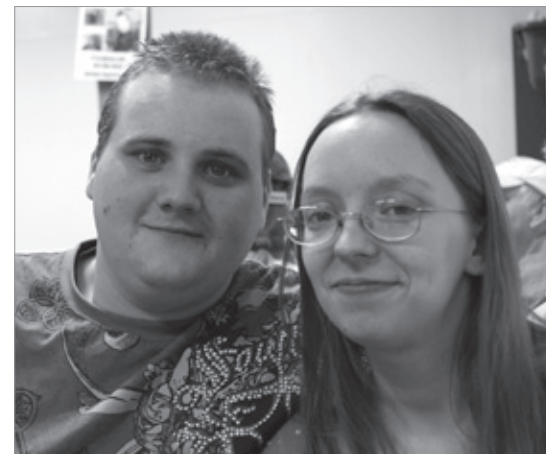

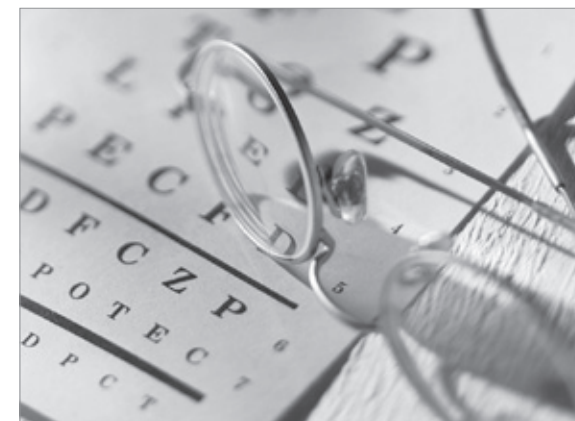

No government grants are received in support of our mission. This frees us to give people the hope of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. This is the express purpose of Foundation Dinners, to show the love of God in Word and deed. Ministering the Gospel in word and deed by supplying a safe environment, free meals and loving care.



EVERY DAY All Day

FOUNDATION PROVIDING 3 MEALS A DAY

Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are being served daily 7 days a week, 365 days a year now. Breakfast is at 8:00 am, Lunch at noon and Dinner at 4:30 pm. This has opened a door of opportunity for more volunteers and is supplying the homeless with 3 meals a day. These meals are open and free to all that are in need and we have seen a good response. DAY TIME SHELTER

Foundation Dinners is now providing also a place for the homeless to stay when the local shelters are closed. We open at 8:00 am and are closed at 5:30 pm every day so that homeless can have a refuge from the weather and have a safe place to stay through the day.



Leon and Kristi with their family have been with us since 1994 and come faithfully every month to serve and prepare meals for the homeless and needy. They own and operate the House of Blessing at 1295 Lincoln Avenue in Lancaster where you can find herbs and health food supplies.
